Take a walk down Jetty Road for everything you need in the one retail strip. We've put together your itinerary...

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**J**etty Road has its fair share of bargain shops and everyday accessories but dip your toes a little deeper and there is glitz and glamour that would make Paris Hilton proud.

Beachside beauties such as Paris do require a glamorous glow, and at Skin Things (99b Jetty Rd, 8294 0022), you can be scrubbed and polished like a celebrity without breaking the bank (last month's special offer was \$240 worth of treatments priced at an affordable \$99). The Australian-made beauty products are completely natural and once you leave, you will not only look the part, but you will be more than ready to discover some more glittering Jetty jewels...

Less Jetty Road and more surfing USA are the Nixon watches at Shades (32 Jetty Rd, 8294 5450), these colourful retro buys give any wrist a funky twist and are so sexy that even Angelina Jolie would have one on her wish list.

Speaking of granting wishes, Wishart jewellers (29 Jetty Rd, 8295 1345) has been dazzling the Glenelg glamour set with custom-made jewellery for more

than five decades. This third-generation jeweller can fashion just about anything, from engagement rings to tiaras and, unlike most city chains, the jeweller who takes your order is likely to be the person who actually makes it. Check out the stunning 138-carat lemon quartz necklace in the window. If it's still there...

Rehydration and sustenance needs are imperative in any retail precinct and this shopping strip has all your tastes catered for. Sweet lovers should head for Bracegirdles (31 Jetty Rd, 8294 8482) where chocolate is the new black. You can keep it moderately healthy by dipping fruit into a fondue of melted heaven or admit defeat and indulge in a hot chocolate with a subtle hint of chilli or orange. Or treat yourself to one of Sarah Neil's lemon hazelnut truffles, which took out top ganache truffle at this year's Royal Adelaide Show. Enjoy whatever you choose in the balcony room, open 'til 10pm Friday-Saturday.

For savoury munchies, head east to Pasta Gourmet (89 Jetty Rd, 8295 8900). Exclusive to this part of town, the name suggests pasta only but, as well as the

tempting carbonara and ravioli take-home packs, there is also a non-pasta breakfast and lunch menu, as well as scrumptious slices and coffees with personality. For a low-calorie celebrity staple, sushi plates can be found at Simply Sushi (108 Jetty Rd, 8294 5514) with prices from \$2.50 to \$6. Thai lovers can feast at Phuket (162 Jetty Rd, 8295 1903). And for something fishy, Europa at the Bay (12-14 Jetty Rd, 8376 3995) is best for delicious seafood, washed down with a glass of Australian sparkling.

For the home? There's nowhere better than the Ivy Room (59a Jetty Rd, 8294 9171). Non-toxic soy candles create mood lighting while Demeter's quirky tomato and lettuce perfumes sound like a supermodel's dinner but will definitely squirt some light into your life. If salad isn't your taste, then adding one of Anna Chandler's Indian tile collection from Sense Appeal (59 Jetty Rd, 8295 8807) should do the trick. Want more?
